## State Medical & Dental PG seats Allotments 2017

### Frequently Asked Questions

(Choice filling, Allotment, Reporting)

- Q. If I opt for NRI seat and am allotted against NRI quota and I do not join / report at the allotted college against NRI seat, then will I be eligible for any type of subsequent round of allotment?

- Q. What are different requirements for admission against NRI quota seat?  
Refer the websites and in particular information related to NRI admission. Also refer the website of the respective medical / dental college.
- Q. I am facing difficulty in filling the choices, on-line. What to do?  
Send email (from the same email ID as filled in your registration form to Helpline at [prepg2017@gmail.com](mailto:prepg2017@gmail.com) mentioning the difficulty being faced alongwith your name, registration ID, in the mail or contact at [7733889594](tel:7733889594) between 12.00 noon and 6.00 pm.
- Q. How should I fill the choices of colleges, courses and subjects, on-line?  
The process of filling choices is given in the – **Instructions for choice filling** available at the website. Read it carefully before you start filling the choices of colleges, courses and subjects, on-line.
- Q. What is the process of on-line allotment?  
a. Registration  
b. Choice filling and auto-locking  
c. Process of seat allotment – round 1  
d. Round 1 result publication  
e. Reporting at the allotted college against round 1
- Q. From where I can fill the choices, on-line?  
On-line choice filling can be done from any place of convenience (including from home) using internet.

Q. [How do I get access to the choice filling screen?](#)

You have to enter by giving your Stream, Registration ID followed by the password assigned to you while doing on-line counseling registration.

You are advised to keep the above information confidential. It is very important for participating in on-line allotment process. Sharing of this information can result in its misuse by somebody else, leading to even exclusion of a genuine candidate from the on-line allotment process.

Q. [What is the minimum and maximum number of choices that I have to fill?](#)

In order to participate in the on-line allotment process, you are required to fill minimum 1 choice. There is no restriction for filling maximum number of choices.

If you do not fill even a single choice, you will not be considered for on-line allotment.

Q. [Do I require attaching any document while filling the choices during on-line allotment process?](#)

No documents will be required to be attached while filling the choices, on-line.

Q. [What documents are required at the time of joining the allotted college?](#)

The documents as mentioned in the instructions booklet / allotment letter will be required at the time of reporting / joining in allotted Medical/Dental College.

Q. [I belong to SC, ST, OBC, SBC category. What certificate am I required to produce at the time of reporting at allotted college?](#)

You are required to submit the valid caste certificate issued by the competent authority. In case you fail to produce the same at allotted Medical / Dental College then you will not be permitted to join the allotted college and your category will be treated as General for the subsequent allotment round (only on the seats remaining vacant after the first round), if otherwise eligible. You will be responsible for such allotment.

Q. [If in round 1, I do not get choice of my higher preference choice, then, is there any possibility of getting a higher preference choice.](#)

Yes. You may be considered for a subsequent round (upward movement) for your higher preference choice. For this, you are required to join allotted college and complete the admission formalities then only you can exercise option to participate in a subsequent round.

Q. [What is subsequent round of allotment process?](#)

Subsequent round of allotment process will be off-line round for upward movement, against the seats remaining vacant due to non-reporting / joining by a candidate at the allotted college, including roll over seats from central counseling, if any.

Fresh choice will be considered in subsequent round of allotment. Choices filled for 1<sup>st</sup> round of allotment will not be considered in subsequent off-line allotment round.

Q. [Who is eligible for subsequent round of allotment?](#)

Candidates eligible for seat allotment in subsequent round would be as below:

Candidates who reported at the allotted college after their allotment at any stage of the allotment process.

Candidates who completed the registration process (registration form submission) of State Medical & Dental PG seats On-line Allotments 2017 and could not subsequently fill choices for 1st round of on-line allotment process.

Candidates who filled their choice(s) and did not get any seat allotment in the 1<sup>st</sup> round.

Candidates, who were allotted a seat against reserved (caste) category in 1<sup>st</sup> round and their 1<sup>st</sup> round was cancelled during the document verification on reporting for admission as they could not produce caste certificate, but would still be eligible for the next round of seat allotment, with changed criteria (i.e. from reserved to unreserved).

Q. [Who is not eligible for subsequent round of allotment?](#)

Not reported at allotted college after seat allotment at any round.

Reported & withdrawn from counseling at allotted college.

Became non-eligible due to change of eligibility criteria during document verification.
